

How to assemble a Tropical J's granite base with stainless steel riser. These instructions are good for a small or large riser attaching to large or small granite base. Please note, if your base is equipped with wheels and handles, it should **ONLY** be used to transport the **base only**. Never transport your base with the umbrella inside; the wheels and handle are not designed to carry that much weight. Failure to follow the directions and/or improper tightening could result in failure and personal injury and/or death.

**Instructions**

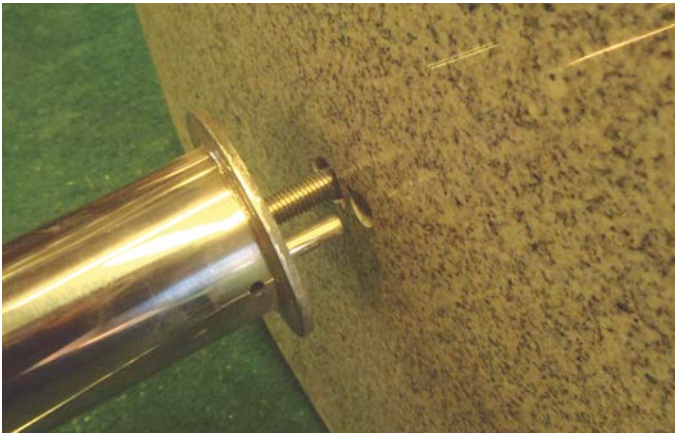
1. Open up the box and check that you have all the parts.
2. Remove the plastic wrap from the riser.
3. Take the through bolt and place the lock washer, and then the flat washer onto it. Your bolt might look a little different than the one shown.



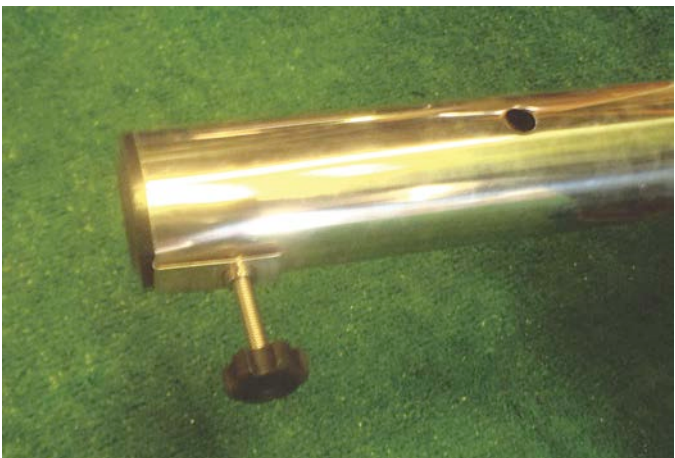
4. Put a little bit of Loctite Red on the end of the bolt.
5. Stand the base up on its side exposing the bottom hole. For larger bases, a second person is suggested to keep the base from falling over and causing personal injury.
6. Push the through bolt through the hole until you expose the thread on the top side of the granite base.



7. Start screwing the riser onto the exposed bolt. Once the two are connected, orient the riser so that the pin matches up to the hole in the top of the granite base. This pin keeps the riser from spinning.



8. Using the  $\frac{3}{4}$ " socket on the socket wrench, tighten the bolt until the riser is bolted firm to the base.
9. Set the base down and insert the thumb screw into the riser.



10. Your base is now ready for use.
